

#### **EXECUTION SHED**

Our restored Victorian hanging pit held the original keys to the Jail, along with many more fascinating items, currently on display.





#### **CIVIL PRISON / EXHIBITION**

Explore the extended and improved 6 floors of the Civil Prison—including the 1880's bakery and administration areas.

#### HISTORY

The original Jail was fit for a king, built for King George III in 1779. Today's jail though was built with the help of the prisoners who brought 20,000 tons of granite from Bodmin's Cuckoo Quarry. Marvel at the building's unique design, architecture and engineering. It has also held within its walls the renowned Domesday Book and State Papers in WWI.

#### THE NAVAL PRISON

The Naval Prison was opened in 1887 and used for the detention of Navy personnel.



### **FOOD AND DRINK**


The Governor's Hall restaurant and licensed wine bar will keep your taste buds locked up with a range of homemade food using locally sourced ingredients.
